RE: Urgent need of Medical Mission Team for The Philippines Typhoon Victims in Manila

GAiN Australia is currently assisting with the Philippine Typhoon Urgent Relief Project. We really appreciate your generous contribution. 2x40 ft containers of humanitarian aid have arrived in Philippines and four more containers are on the way.

Since our Philippine typhoon appeal letter in October, four more typhoons have hit the nation and Manila, the capital of the Philippines is still heavily flooded. This added disaster has increased workload of the local medical mission team which has been working tirelessly since early October.

Very recently our local contacts in the Philippines have requested GAiN Australia to send a medical team to share the demanding workload as most of the local medical team members are exhausted from working long hours for more than one month.

In response to this urgent request, GAiN Australia is inviting you, especially medical professionals, to prayerfully consider joining this Philippine Medical mission in January and share the love of God.

The Medical Mission trip dates are from 4th of January, 2010 till 11th of January, 2010. The anticipated cost of the trip is approximately \$2,500.
